## **A WORD ABOUT THE MONTESSORI SYSTEM OF EDUCATION**

Dr. Maria Montessori was an Italian Educator and Doctor. She became the first Italian woman to receive a medical degree when she graduated from the University of Rome in 1896. The Educational methods she advocated were so successful that they became popular word over. Her Education approach came to be known as Montessori Method.

### **WHAT IS THE MONTESSORI METHOD ?**

Montessori is a philosophy and a method of education, which emphasizes the potential of the young child and which develops this potential by utilizing specially trained teachers and special teaching materials.

Montessori recognizes in the children the natural curiosity and desire to learn. The Montessori Materials kindle this desire and channelize the curiosity into a learning experience which the children enjoy. Montessori Materials help children to understand what they learn by associating an abstract concept with a concrete sensorial experience: in this manner, the Montessori child is actually learning, not just memorizing. The Montessori Method stresses that children learn and progress at their own pace so that fast learners are not held back and slow learners are not frustrated by their inability to keep up.

### **MONTESSORI EDUCATORS**

Montessori educators serve as role models and encourage students in the first two age groups to use their sense of touch, sight, hearing, smell and taste to explore and manipulate materials in their own environment.

Children are assisted by presenting special lessons and materials and are encouraged to explore a topic independently.

The child is developing every moment of his life but the school offers help for about half the number of days in a year and only for a part of the day.

So the atmosphere of the school must continue the ambience of a home.

This feature is specially looked into the house of children where learning takes place for life.

**“Education is a natural process spontaneously carried out by the human individual and is acquired not by listening to words but by experiences in the environment”**

### **HIS GRACE MONTESSORI DRESS CODE:**

- ♦ Child should have a handkerchief pinned up with a baby pin.
- ♦ Student must come neatly dressed in washed and ironed uniform.
- ♦ The child must wear easy slip - on shoes or slippers, which the children can wear all by themselves. Clothes must be loose and comfortable so that it will be comfortable for them to sit on the mat and work in the Montessori environment.
- ♦ Bags, umbrellas, Tiffin boxes, Water bottles should be of simple make and easy to handle. They should be labelled.
- ♦ The school will provide the required stationery.
- ♦ Student should wear uniform from Monday to Friday.
- ♦ During rainy season students are supposed to wear black sandals only

### **ADMISSION PROCEEDURE**

- \* Once admissions opens for the academic year, all the eligible candidates can obtain application for admission from the School Office during the office hours from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on all working days.
- \* Duly filled in applications are to be submitted to the school office along with the Original Transfer Certificate and Date of Birth Certificate of the candidate together with 4 passport Size Photographs of the student on or before the last date of admission.
- \* While seeking admission, the First-term Fees. Activity and Outreach Fees are to be paid.
- \* The student are advised to bring their parents at the time of admission.
- \* Admission fees will be non refundable.

## **ACADEMIC INFORMATION**

### **CURRICULUM**

Montessori system of learning is followed in the pre-schooling. In the primary and Secondary Sections of the school, the curriculum is followed as prescribed by the Central Government and the Central Board of Secondary Education.

However the Curriculum at Bearys Seaside Public School aims at holistic development of the student nourishing their calibre and encouraging them to discover their aptitudes to promote their natural and lasting growth. It is achieved through Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation Curriculum and Scholastic Assessment.

### **CONTINUOUS AND COMPREHENSIVE EVALUATION**

The term Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) is used for school based evaluation of pupils in which their assessment is done on a continuous basis throughout the year and which is also Comprehensive in nature, in the sense that it is not confined to assessment in scholastic subjects but also covers co-scholastic areas such as performance in games/sports, physical education, Creative Education, Art, Music, Dance, Drama other cultural activities and personal & Social qualities.

### **SCHOLASTIC ASSESSMENT**

The term scholastic refers to those aspects which are related to intellect or the brain. It includes assessment of learners in curricular subjects, assignments project work, practical and oral work.

### **COMPUTER APPLICATION/ INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY**

As part of the school curriculum, children are gradually introduced to & oriented in computer operations by teaching them Computer fundamentals and windows applications.

### **SCOUTS AND GUIDES**

Progressive and Stimulating programming of various activities, including games, useful skills and services to the community taking place largely in an outdoor setting contact with nature.

### **CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

We pay attention to the development of creative faculties of the students along with physics and mental development. Various activities like debate, elocution and quiz are conducted class-wise during the school working hours. The school celebrates national days and major religious festivals every year to promote universal brotherhood and harmony. During these functions the children are given lot of opportunities to bring out their latent talents.

### **OUT-REACH AND NATURE CONTACT ACTIVITIES**

Class-wise excursion and tours will be arranged every year to places of interest. This gives each child an opportunity to intermingle & develop team spirit, become adaptable and gain a sense of independence.

## **EXAMINATION AND ASSESSMENT REPORT**

1. The continuous Comprehensive Evaluation report is maintained for each student. It contains the progress of the student in academic as well co-curricular and extra-curricular activities and it is consistently monitored by the class teacher and subject teachers.
2. The examinations are conducted according to the time-table announced before hand.
3. In addition to the Terminal and Final examinations, monthly tests are held. The promotion of a student is based on his/her performance in the tests and examinations.
4. The students qualify to write the examinations after paying all the dues.
5. The students who remain absent for any examination due to illness shall produce the Medical Certificate.
6. The Student are promoted to the next class according the rules in force.
7. A Teachers Council is the Constituted to decide on the promotion of the students and the decision of the Council is final and binding.

## **TRANSPORTATION**

The school runs its own vehicles to facilitate easy communication for the student

- The students are advised to register their names in the School Office at the time of admission by filling the prescribed form to avail the school bus service.
- The students have to carefully note pick-up points, the timings and the bus route.
- All the end of the school hours, the students are picked from the school gate.
- The students have to take care to see that the van fees are paid in time to avoid any consequential action.

## **MEDICAL INSPECTION**

- Medical Inspection is held scheduled in a year.
- The School has a First Aid facility in to provided immediate medical aid
- Timely medical facility is provided to the student in times of need.
- Student in need of special medical attention will be taken to the Nursing Home and parents are apprised of the same.

## **LIBRARY**

1. All students of the school are the members of the library.
2. The students are required to maintain discipline and be silent in the library.
3. Students of classes III to X can borrow one book each at a time.
4. Library books are issued and taken back during the library period of the concerned class.
5. The students are advised to handle the Library books carefully and return the books before the due date.
6. The students shall not indulge in marking, underlining, cutting, defacing, detaching the pages of the books. Such cases would be seriously dealt.
7. Delayed return of book is subject to fine.
8. No Student should take the book magazine or news paper outside the library.

## **RULES GOVERNING THE DISCIPLINE OF THE STUDENT**

1. The students have to conduct themselves in a befitting manner while they are in the school campus.
2. All the students must participate in the school Assembly. Late coming without a valid reason is not admissible.
3. The students shall come to the school in full uniform with their shoes polished and hair done properly.
4. Students are required to bring their school diaries to the school every day.
5. No student should remain outside the classroom once the classes start.
6. The students should learn to handle the school property carefully. Attempts to damage the school property and defacing the walls and causing any kind of damage in any way will be seriously dealt.
7. The students should not bring any valuables to the school. The school shall not be responsible for loss of any such article. The students shall not possess the mobile phones in the school campus. The students should keep their classes and the school compound spotlessly clean.
8. The students should remain in their respective classes during the study time and engage themselves seriously in studies.
9. Students are always expected to set standard of good conduct and politeness in the school, in the buses and at public places. The school is judged by the conduct of the students. They should greet their teachers and elders whenever they meet them.
10. The Students are not allowed to leave the school premises while the classes are going on without the permission of the Principal

11. The Students should come to the school with lessons prepared and home work done.
12. The students should keep only those books which are in the curriculum and irrelevant books are not to be brought to the school.
13. It is compulsory for the student to actively participate and attend all the functions of school.

## **GUIDELINES TO THE PARENTS**

1. Parents are requested to read the diary and ensure that the student adheres to the instruction of the institution.
2. Parents can meet the teachers on the third saturday of every month between 9-30 a.m. and 12-30 p.m. When the parents come to the school for meeting the teachers, they are requested to meet the Principal first who will arrange for meeting with the teachers. The parents are requested not to go directly to the class and meet the teachers as it disturbs the academic process.
3. The Parents are requested to address any form of communication that they wish to make to the school to the Principal While doing so, the parents are requested to give full details such as the name of the student, the class in which he/she is studying and any other information.
4. The Parents are requested to avoid giving unreasonable amount of pocket money to their children.
5. The Parents are requested to communicate any changes in their address and phone number to the school to update the records.
6. Based on the directives of the WHO (World Health Organisation) and the CBSE, we have banned the bringing and consumed of Junk food of all kinds at school. We also urge parents to enforce this ban at home and safeguard the health of our children.

## **LEAVE RULES**

1. The school provides a holiday list well in advance to facilitate the parents to plan their holidays. Children should not be taken for holidays during school session.
2. No student shall remain absent without prior permission of the Principal. Leave will be granted on written application from parents or guardians.
3. A student who remains absent without prior permission of the Principal will not be allowed to attend the classes without the formal sanction of the Principal. A letter from the parent is not produced to the Principal with a valid reason for absence.
4. Where a student remains absent for more than a month, the school is compelled to strike off the name of such student from the Rolls.
5. The student should inform their class teacher of their absence.
6. A student who remains absent for five consecutive days without the permission invites disciplinary action.

## **PARENTS CO-OPERATION**

In regulation the conduct and the academic progress of the students, parents play a vital role and therefore they are requested to co-operate with the teachers and the management in this regard.

The parents are requested to:

1. Check the school diary of the student and carefully observe the entries as regards assignment, progress late attendance, absence and Principal remarks.
2. Observe the school rules and regulation and ensure that the student adheres to them.

3. See that no presentation/ gift is given to any teacher.
4. Ensure that no teacher of the school is engaged for giving private tuition to the student.
5. See that the student maintains regularity and punctuality in attending the school and the classes.
6. See that the student conducts his/her studies on continuous basis.
7. See that the student look neat and presentable.
8. Discourage the student from attending the social functions at the cost of the classes.
9. Be an active member of the parent-Teacher Association of the school
10. Feel free talk to the Principal on any matters affection the student
11. Visit the school for any clarification preferably during the afternoon sessions.

### **A PIECE OF ADVICE TO THE STUDENTS :**

1. Not down your assignments with dilligence make your own time table and follow it vigorously.
2. Complete the homework and assignments regularly.
3. Cultivate the habit of making revisions and never be over-confident.
4. Respect elders at home and teachers at school.

6. Take part in school activities and earn extra mileage.
