



A WORD ABOUT THE MONTESSORI SYSTEM OF EDUCATION

Dr. Maria Montessori was an Italian Educator and Doctor. She became the first Italian woman to receive a medical degree when she graduated from the University of Rome in 1896. The Educational methods she advocated were so successful that they became popular word over. Her Education approach came to be known as Montessori Method.

WHAT IS THE MONTESSORI METHOD?

Montessori is a philosophy and a method of education, which emphasizes the potential of the young child and which develops this potential by utilizing specially trained teachers and special teaching materials.

Montessori recognizes in the children the natural curiosity and desire to learn. The Montessori Materials kindle this desire and channelize the curiosity into a learning experience which the children enjoy. Montessori Materials help children to understand what they learn by associating an abstract concept with a concrete sensorial experience: in this manner, the Montessori child is actually learning, not just memorizing. The Montessori Method stresses that children learn and progress at their own pace so that fast learners are not held back and slow learners are not frustrated by their inability to keep up.

MONTESSORI EDUCATORS

Montessori educators serve as role models and encourage students in the first two age groups to use their sense of touch, sight, hearing, smell and taste to explore and manipulate materials in their own environment.

Children are assisted by presenting special lessons and materials and are encouraged to explore a topic independently.

The child is developing every moment of his life but the school offers help for about half the number of days in a year and only for a part of the day. So the atmosphere of the school must continue the ambience of a home. This feature is specially looked into the house of children where learning takes place for life.

CODE OF CONDUCT

At Bearys Seaside Public School CBSE, we believe in creating a safe, respectful, and inclusive learning environment that fosters academic excellence, personal growth, and positive social interactions. The following Code of Conduct outlines the behavioral expectations and standards of conduct that govern student behavior within our school community. By adhering to these principles, we uphold the values of respect, responsibility, integrity, and empathy.

1. Attendance, Regularity and Leave Rules.

- All Students are expected to be regular in their attendance to school.
- Regular attendance in classes is a condition for promotion. A Student will not be promoted to the next higher class if his/her attendance falls below 80%
- Student attendance on reopening day after every vacation is mandatory.
- Application for leave has to be applied for by the parent, in the school Handbook, if it is for 1-2 days, and sanctioned obtained from the class teacher.
- Leave for 3 days or more has to be sought by the parent in a separate application addressed to the Principal & sanction obtained.
- Medical certificate has to be submitted if it is for health reasons & class teacher must be notified.
- The students will not be given any retest if any they have missed the same for any reason.
- Students who need to leave early need an Authorization letter from their parents without which they will not be allowed to leave the school campus.

2. School uniform

- All the students must be in school uniform on all working days right from the beginning of the school year.
- The uniform should be clean & tidy, shirts should be neatly tucked into their trousers & school belt must be clearly visible
- The failure to adhere to the uniform guidelines may result in the student being sent home after two warnings recorded in the handbook.

His Grace Montessori Dress Code:

- Child should have a handkerchief pinned up with a baby pin.
- Student must come neatly dressed in washed and ironed uniform.
- The child must wear easy slip-on shoes or slippers, which the children can wear all by themselves.
- Clothes must be loose and comfortable so that it will be comfortable for them to sit on the mat and work in the Montessori environment.

- Bags, umbrellas, Tiffin boxes, Water bottles should be of simple make and easy to handle. They should be labeled.
- The school will provide the required stationery.
- Student should wear uniform from Monday to Friday.

3. ID card

- It is mandatory for students to wear their updated student ID cards given by school in the school premises.

4. Footwear

- Students have to wear footwear/shoes & socks as specified by the school.
- Shoes & socks will be worn on all days, except on rainy days.
- Students are expected to wear decent black sandals during the rainy days.

5. Hair style

- **Boys must maintain their hair trimmed neatly in short length. No fancy haircut is allowed.**
- Girls with shoulder-length hair must wear two pony tails with black rubber bands. Girls should plait their hair if it is below the shoulder using a black rubber band.

6. Late arrival

- **The school gates will close 5 minutes before the assembly. Hence late entry will not be entertained.**

7. Assembly

- Attending assembly is compulsory for students on all days.
- Students ought to be sincere & respectful during the assembly.

8. Language

- Speaking English will be mandatory on our school camps. The initiative aims to improve communication skills and equip individuals for global prospects.

9. Parents' visit to school

- Parents are requested to visit the school only during office hours on working days.
- Parents visiting school must go to the school office & not to faculty rooms or classrooms.
- Parents are encouraged to meet the teachers concerned on Saturdays with prior permission.
- Parents shall not come to take children home during school working hours for any reason.
- Parents who wish to meet the principal & teacher would do well to seek a prior appointment.
- Parents are requested to contact the School Office at first and ask to meet the teachers and principal.

10. Correspondence from the school

- Letters sent to parents must be properly responded. Parents, when called to school, must understand that there is something very important to be discussed with them.

11. Birthdays

- Students will be allowed to distribute chocolates/ sweets to their classmates.
- Cake cutting in class is strictly prohibited.
- Students should wear uniforms even on birthdays.

12. Scholarships

- Scholarships will be provided to students on their academic excellence.
- Financial assistance will be provided to the meritorious students.

13. General Guidelines

- **Parents are requested not to allow children to bring pendrives, ipods, cameras, mobile phones, videogames or similar gadgets to the School. A fine of Rs.500/- will be levied for each offence.**
- Students are not permitted to bring money to the school, unless there is a clear instruction from the school to bring money for a particular purpose.
- Students shall not buy and supply any items to the hostel students.
- Parents are requested to write the child's name and class on his/ her belongings such as water-bottles, tiffin-carriers, umbrellas etc.
- **Smart watches** are banned in the school and if any student is found with smart watches in the school, including the school buses, it will be confiscated and a hefty fine will be levied and parents will be notified.
- **Chewing gum** also is prohibited in the school premises, including in the school buses. Any violation of this rule will lead to serious disciplinary action. A heavy fine also will be levied and parents will be notified.
- **Junk food banned in school** based on the directives of the **WHO (World Health Organization)** and the **CBSE**, we have banned the bringing and consuming of junk food of all kinds at school. We also urge parents to enforce this ban at home and safeguard the health of our children.
- Children who contract communicable diseases like **mumps, chickenpox, measles, herpes etc should not be sent to school until a qualified doctor certifies their fitness to attend school.** Such children shall not be sent to school earlier, under any circumstances. After the child has recovered completely, the parent has to meet the principal concerned with the child and get permission to send the child by school bus.
- Parents have a responsibility to encourage modest, decent and tasteful dressing habits, conforming to acceptable social mores, amongst children from very early stages of their development.
- Usage of mobile phone is strictly prohibited. Parents shall take note of the serious consequences of mobile addiction. It is a curse that distracts children from their studies. Please therefore take

steps to sensitize children on the ill-effects of the excessive use of mobile phones and social media.

- Students have to be extremely careful and act responsibly while interacting on social media. Posting negative messages, photographs, videos, memes on social media about fellow students/school/ teachers is unacceptable. The student and the parents will be liable for an explanation. There is **ZERO TOLERANCE** for derogatory and offensive messages posted on social media about any stakeholder.
- Pupils are expected to keep the school premises clean.
- Nails must be kept short & clean .Nail polish & tattoos are not permitted.
- School property should be respected.
- The school authorities have provided a conducive learning environment. Students are to strictly refrain from defacing the school property with graffiti.
- Any loss or damage to the school property caused by the students will have to be paid for by the parents/guardians.
- Gentle and polite behaviour is expected from every pupil.
- Bullying, or lowering the self-esteem of a fellow student in any form, will not be tolerated for a safe and secure learning environment. Students who feel are victims of bullying must report to the class teacher/ school counsellor/ CODs.
- Students must maintain discipline in the corridors at all times. They should not leave the class after every period or loiter in the corridors.
- Movement between classrooms should be done in a disciplined manner. Students should keep to the left when walking in the corridors or climbing up or down the stairs.

Violation of the Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary consequences, which may include but are not limited to verbal warnings, written warnings, detention, suspension depending on the severity and frequency of the offense. Disciplinary actions will be administered in a fair, consistent, and proportionate manner, with consideration for the best interests of the student and the school community. All members of the school community, including students, parents, guardians, faculty, and staff, are expected to familiarize themselves with this Code of Conduct and actively contribute to maintaining a positive and respectful school climate.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Once admissions opens for the academic year, all the eligible candidates can obtain application for admission from the School Office during the office hours from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on all working days.
- Duly filled in applications are to be submitted to the school office along with the Original Transfer Certificate and Date of Birth Certificate of the candidate together with 4 passport Size Photographs of the student on or before the last date of admission.
- While seeking admission, the First-term Fees. Activity and Outreach Fees are to be paid.
- Children should accompany their parents at the time of admission.
- Admission fees will be non refundable.

ACADEMIC INFORMATION

CURRICULUM

Montessori system of learning is followed in the pre-schooling in the primary and Secondary Sections of the school, the curriculum is followed as prescribed by the Central Government and the Central Board of Secondary Education.

However the Curriculum at Bearys Seaside Public School aims at holistic development of the student nourishing their calibre and encouraging them to discover their aptitudes to promote their natural and lasting growth. It is achieved through Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation Curriculum and Scholastic Assessment.

CONTINUOUS AND COMPREHENSIVE EVALUATION

The term Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) is used for school based evaluation of pupils in which their assessment is done on a continuous basis throughout the year and which is also Comprehensive in nature, in the sense that it is not confined to assessment in scholastic subjects but also covers co-scholastic areas such as performance in games/sports, physical education, Creative Education, Art, Music, Dance, Drama other cultural activities and personal & Social qualities.

SCHOLASTIC ASSESSMENT

The term scholastic refers to those aspects which are related to intellect or the brain. It includes assessment of learners in curricular subjects, assignments project work, practical and oral work

COMPUTER APPLICATION/ INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

As part of the school curriculum, children are gradually introduced to & oriented in computer operations by teaching them Computer fundamentals and windows applications.

SCOUTS AND GUIDES

Progressive and Stimulating programming of various activities, including games, useful skills and services to the community taking place largely in an outdoor setting contact with nature.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

We pay attention to the development of creative faculties of the students along with physics and mental development. Various activities like debate, elocution and quiz are conducted class-wise during the school working hours. The school celebrates national days and major religious festivals every year to promote universal brotherhood and harmony. During these functions the children are given lot of opportunities to bring out their latent talents.

OUT-REACH AND NATURE CONTACT ACTIVITIES

Class-wise excursion and tours will be arranged every year to places of interest. This gives each child an opportunity to intermingle & develop team spirit, become adaptable and gain a sense of independence.

EXAMINATION AND ASSESSMENT REPORT

1. The Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation report is maintained for each student. It contains the progress of the student in academic as well co-curricular and extra-curricular activities and it is consistently monitored by the class teacher and subject teachers.
2. The examinations are conducted according to the time-table announced before hand.
3. In addition to the Terminal and Final examinations, monthly tests are held. The promotion of a student is based on his/her performance in the tests and examinations.
4. The students qualify to write the examinations after paying all the dues.
5. The students who remain absent for any examination due to illness shall produce the Medical Certificate.
6. The Students are promoted to the next class according the rules in force.
7. A Teachers Council is the Constituted to decide on the promotion of the students and the decision of the Council is final and binding.
8. A re-examination will be conducted after the results if the student's performance is found unsatisfactory.
9. Re-examination in the best interest of the students (Re-exam: A chance to shine brighter and reach higher!"
